Attendance & Tardiness

The paramount purpose of the Elementary K-5 Attendance Policy is to instill in students of Lapeer Community Schools the value of good school attendance and punctuality to class. Lapeer schools are genuinely concerned anytime a student is absent or tardy. It is essential to recognize that both school and home have a shared responsibility to build desirable habits of punctuality and attendance.

Tardy AM : A student is marked "Missed Instruction" if he/she arrives to school **between 8:24 and 9:24am**. (8:44 – 9:44am Year Round Calendar)

Absence AM : A student is marked absent a half-day in the morning if he/she arrives to school **after 9:24am**. (after 9:44am Year Round Calendar)

Absence PM : A student is marked absent a half-day in the afternoon if he/she leaves school **before 2:30pm**. (before 3:40pm Year Round Calendar)

Tardy PM : A student is marked "Missed Instruction" if he/she leaves **between 2:31 – 3:20pm**. (2:41 – 3:40pm Year Round Calendar)
